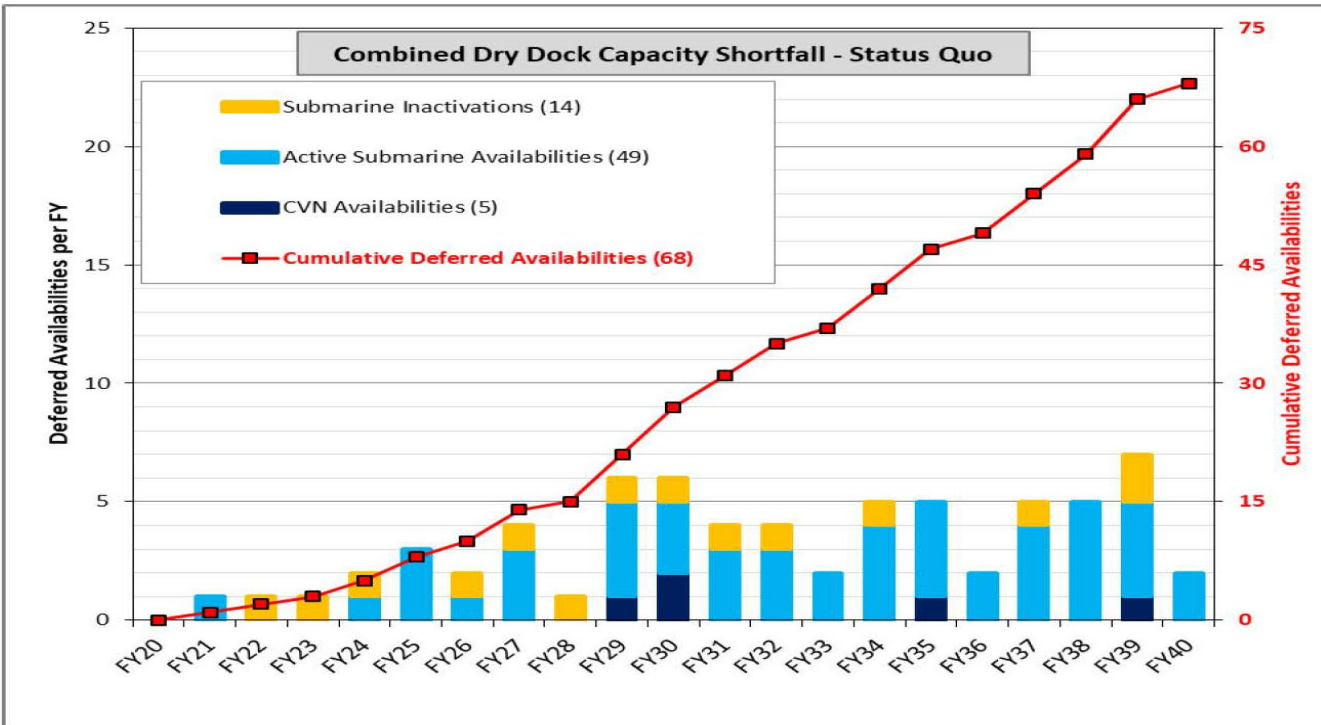
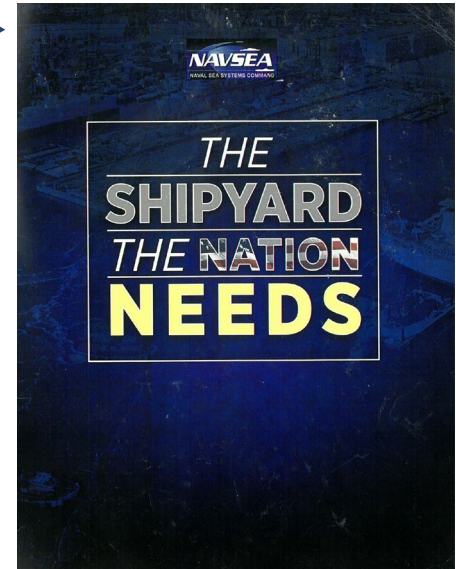

Nationwide Programmatic Agreement (NPA)

- Consult with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, National Conference of State Historic Preservation Officers, 4 State Historic Preservation Officers, Native Americans and Native Hawaiians, the National Park Service, NGOs, and the public to develop a Nationwide Programmatic Agreement (PA) for compliance with NHPA Sections 106 and 110 for shipyard modernization actions at the public shipyards and future IMFs, as applicable.
- Establish in the NPA a framework for shipyard-specific Local Management Procedures (LMP) to govern compliance with Section 106 and Section 110 and ongoing planning and implementation of the optimization program.

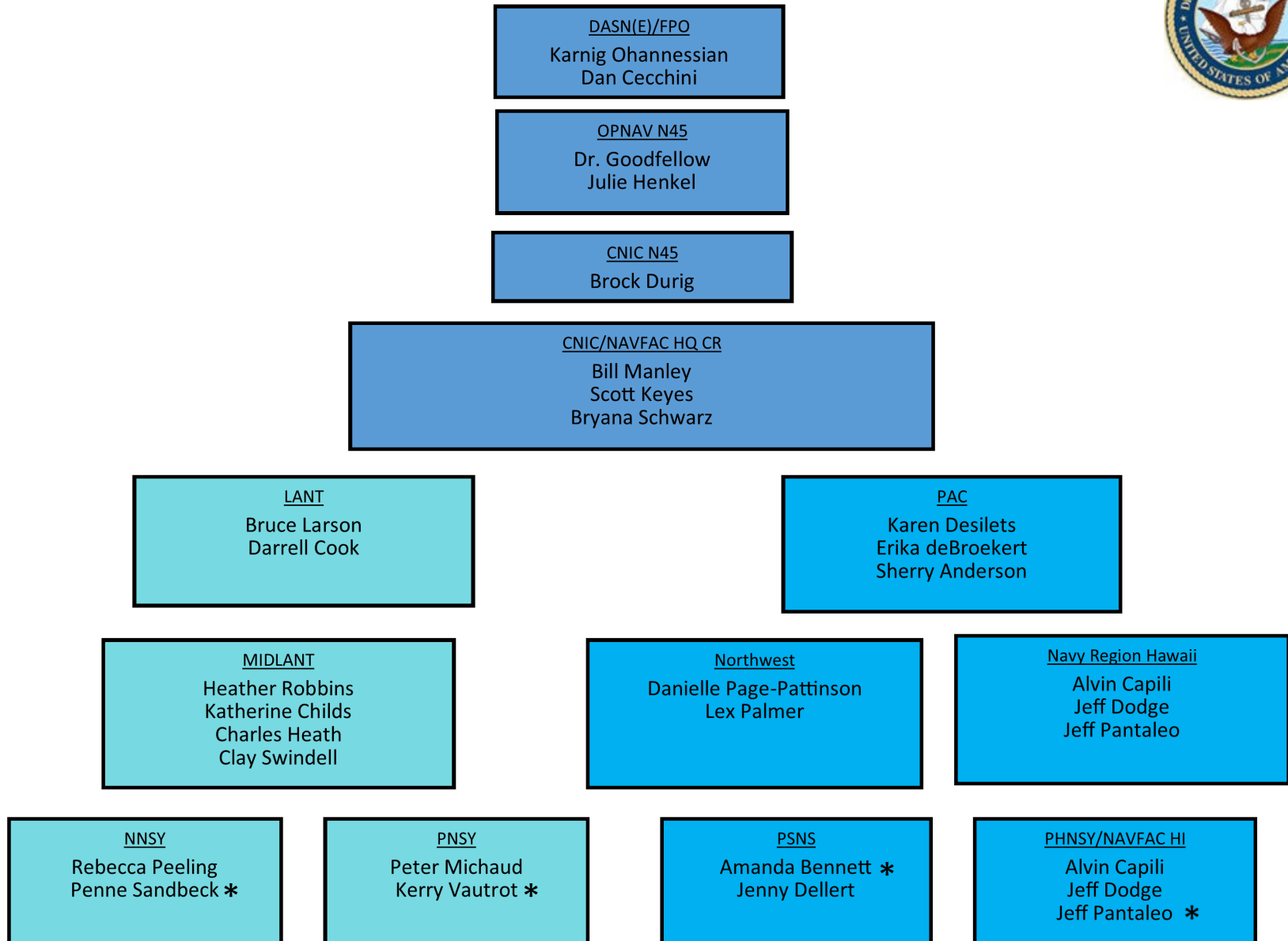

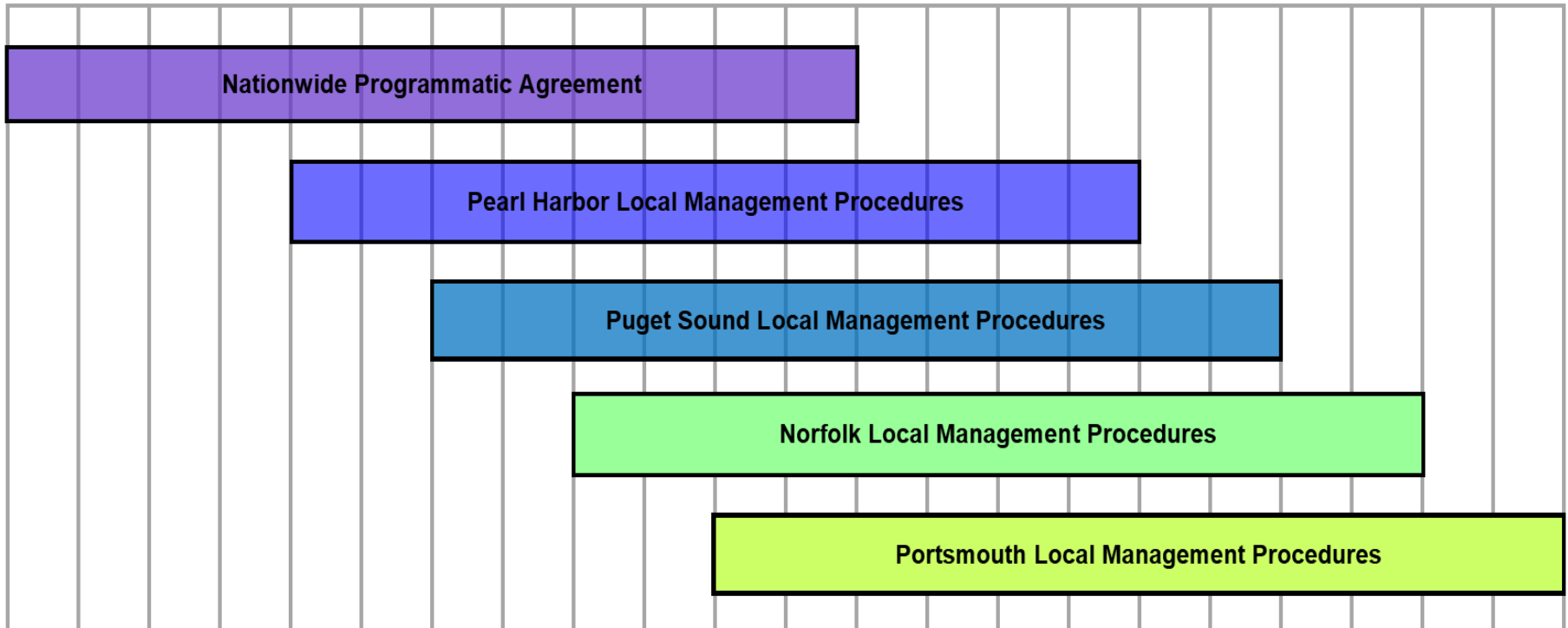
